Purpose of consultancy:	To develop an online course on sexual and reproductive health for university students aged 18-24. Specifically, the consultant is expected to develop a work plan for the course structure, a course name, and advice on visual design, as well as a package of content script, content for activities, quiz and a certificate. The consultant needs to ensure that the course is age-appropriate, evidence and skills-based and in line with international standards.	
Scope of work: (Description of services, activities, or outputs)	<b>Rational:</b> The sexual and reproductive choices of young people can have a cascading effect on their human rights. Unintended pregnancy, for example, can lead young women to drop out of school, which deprives them of their right to education. Poor understanding of gender equality can lead to discrimination and gender-based violence. Adequate information on sexual and reproductive health enables young people to protect their health, well-being and dignity.	
	In the digital education environment, young people are responding to challenges of the day with innovative approaches. UNFPA and its partner plan to develop an online course for university students on Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE), which includes information and discussions on sexual and reproductive health, relationships, culture and gender roles, and also addresses human rights, gender equality, and threats such as discrimination and sexual abuse.	
	<b>Learning objectives:</b> Through a comprehensive learning on age-appropriate, evidence and skills-based CSE concepts, students would be empowered to make responsible decisions for their own bodies and lives in the college years and in their future development.	
	The consultant will be responsible for the following tasks:	
	<ul> <li>Developing a functional work plan features the online course structure, a course name and visual design advice for review and validation;</li> <li>Instructionally designing the content of the online course based on accurate information, evidence and consultations with relevant stakeholders.</li> <li>Proposing a catchy and an interesting name for the online course that would meet young people's desires.</li> <li>Producing a self-paced, well-structured and interactive online course package in line with the International Technical Guidance on Sexuality Education (ITGSE).</li> <li>Conduct regular updates with UNFPA while adjusting work results upon requests and needs.</li> </ul>	
	Modality:	
	<ul> <li>The online course should be activities-based with a combination of videos, scenario based information and quiz.</li> <li>The online course should cover topics promoted by CSE and should be age-appropriate and human-centered, in consideration of the younger generation's needs.</li> <li>The online course should be developed in English and is expected to take no more than 60 minutes to complete.</li> <li>Participants who complete the course and pass the quiz will be awarded with a certificate, and those who cannot pass the quiz should restudy.</li> <li>The format of the online course can refer to BSAFE, an online security awareness training developed by UNFPA: <a href="https://training.dss.un.org/course/category/6">https://training.dss.un.org/course/category/6</a></li> </ul>

The online course is designed for university students aged 18-24. It will be piloted in one university and will expand to 18 universities in China.
